One simple way you can help steward the Pacific Bonsai Museum's bonsai collection for future generations is to leave a charitable bequest to the Museum.

A bequest to Pacific Bonsai Museum is free from federal and state taxes and can be made either outright or contingent upon the death of the named beneficiary. The amount of the bequest is deducted from your estate total, offering substantial savings by decreasing the value of the estate subject to taxation. There is no limit to the amount of your estate that can be left to charitable organizations.

The following is language that we recommend you use to name Pacific Bonsai Museum as beneficiary of your will or codicil:

"I hereby give, devise and bequeath \$_____ (specific dollar amount) ____, AND/OR ___ percent of the residue of my estate to Pacific Bonsai Museum, a nonprofit Washington corporation exempt from federal taxation under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, currently located at 2515 S 336th St, Federal Way, WA 98003, federal tax identification number: 61-1727426."*
